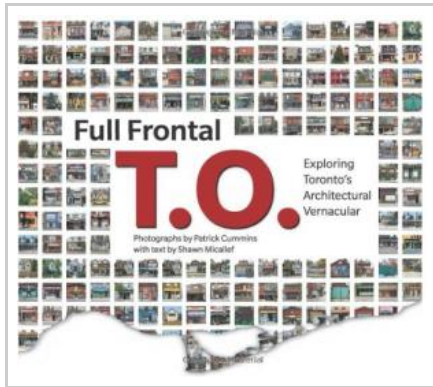




Full Frontal T.O.: Exploring Toronto's Architectural Vernacular
