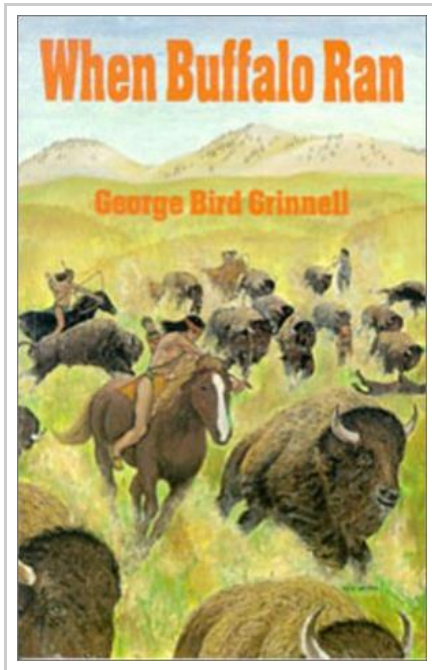




When Buffalo Ran
