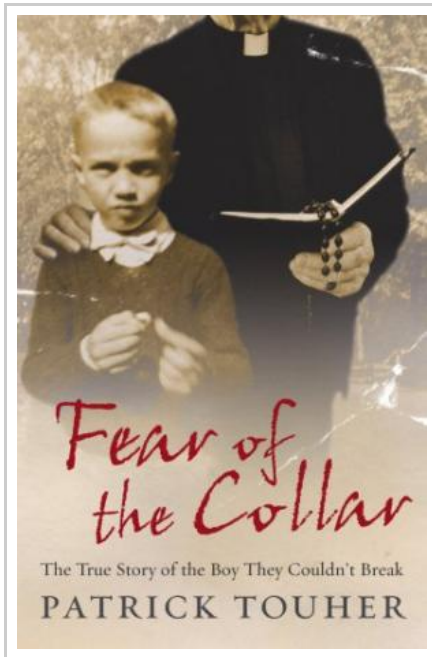




Fear of the Collar: The True Story of the Boy They Couldn't Break
