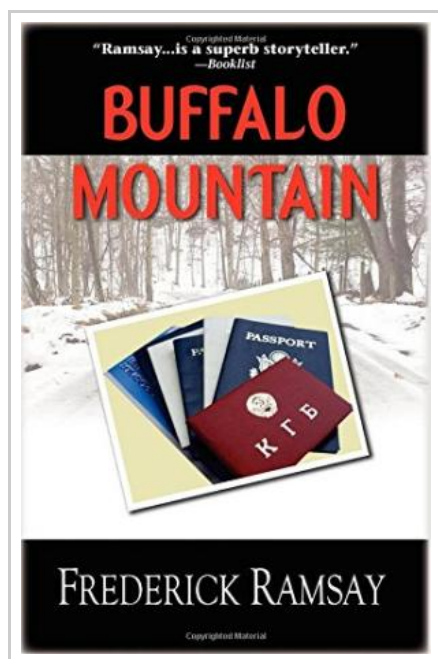




Buffalo Mountain (Paperback)
